The Presentation

The incumbent leads the new priest to the Bishop and says:

Bishop, I present to you Pamela Jean Macnaughton to serve as Assistant Curate (to be known as Associate Priest) of the benefice of Ripley.

Bishop Thank you for your presentation. Let the oaths be taken and the declaration be made in accordance with the law.

Oath of Allegiance to Her Majesty The Queen

The new priest, holding a Bible, faces the people and says:

I, Pamela Jean Macnaughton, do swear that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance to Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second, her heirs and successors, according to law. So help me God.

Oath of Canonical Obedience

The priest then faces the Bishop and says:

I, Pamela Jean Macnaughton, do swear by almighty God that I will pay true and canonical obedience to the Bishop of Derby, and her successors, in all things lawful and honest. So help me God.

Declaration of Assent

The Bishop says:

The Church of England is part of the one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church worshipping the one true God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. It professes the faith uniquely revealed in the Holy Scriptures and set forth in the catholic creeds, which faith the Church is called upon to proclaim afresh in each generation. Led by the Holy Spirit, it has borne witness to Christian truth in its historic formularies, the Thirty-nine Articles of Religion, the Book of Common Prayer, and the ordering of Bishops, Priests and Deacons.

In the declaration you are about to make will you affirm your loyalty to this inheritance of faith as your inspiration and guidance under God in bringing the grace and truth of Christ to this generation and making him known to those in your care?

The priest responds:

I, Pamela Jean Macnaughton, do so affirm, and accordingly declare my belief in the faith which is revealed in the Holy Scriptures and set forth in the catholic creeds and to which the historic formularies of the Church of England bear witness: and in public prayer and administration of the sacraments I will use only the forms of service which are authorised or allowed by Canon.
